



Eligibility Criteria, February 2014

Eligible families must meet the following criteria:

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Eligibility Criteria		Evidence
1	Children identify as having high behaviour needs &/or as potentially at risk	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Referral from CYFs • Referral from other social services organisation • Scores from pre-enrolment needs analyses is within identified range
2	Target children are between 0-12 years in age	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Information from referrer / family
3	Families are willing and able to engage in the programme	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signature of referred family members /those wishing to enrol is gained on the <i>Informed Consent & Service Agreement</i> form
4	Referred family members are not identified as presenting a known safety risk to Facilitators.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Information from referrer • Declaration from family member



Priority Criteria, February 2014

Priority Criteria		Evidence
1	Children identify as having <i>highest</i> behaviour needs &/or as <i>most potentially</i> at risk	Comparison of ranking of scores from pre-enrolment needs analyses
2	Target children are between 3-8 years in age	Comparison of ages across families
3	Families are <i>willing</i> and <i>able</i> to engage in the programme	Ranking scale: 0 = family only engaging under duress 1 = family willing to engage but identifies work or other non-changeable factors as barriers 2 = family willing to engage, identified barriers need to be addressed 2 = family willing to engage but not in own home 4 = family willing to engage in own home, but is yet to identify 'good' times to meet, and no safety issues identified 5 = family willing to engage in own home, has identified 'good' times to meet, and no safety issues identified

4	Family description of situation & perceived need ranked as <i>highest</i> .	<p>Ranking scale:</p> <p>0 = family is coping (with or without support)</p> <p>1 = family expresses concern (some family support in place)</p> <p>2 = family expresses concern (some agency support in place)</p> <p>3 = family expresses high level of concern (some family &/or agency support in place)</p> <p>4 = family expresses high level of concern (no agency support in place)</p> <p>5 = family expresses high level of concern (no support in place)</p>
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
